The meeting opened at 7pm. The October 6<sup>th</sup> minutes were amended and approved.

**General Update:** Zoning Administrator Halleran spent a few minutes updating the board on the status of various land use issues:

John Varnese will bring forward a one-lot division at the board's next meeting. John is spinning of a house lot adjacent to his Porter Road residence. The property benefits from having acreage in the VR zone.

The Townline case where neighbors have objected to the town's permitting the business to replace the existing shop building has, after many months of laying dormant, been reactivated by those bringing the suit against the town. A case status hearing will take place the end of this month.

The former Berwick residence at 361 Route 12A will be torn down later this month. The Selectboard has worked with the owner to have the abandoned building removed.

Responding to comments from Halleran, the Planning Board agreed to participate in a possible workshop day that KUA is considering to gather input from the community on various campus wide long range planning issues. As proposed the day would likely include discussions about the post office, the relocation of several buildings and improving pedestrian safety on Main Street. Members of the board encouraged the use of an outside facilitator for running the day.

The Board completed the meeting with a discussion on the work force housing issue. Changes to RSA 674 make it necessary for every town to examine the opportunities for workforce housing in the community. Planning Board members felt that added a section to the existing ordinance to specifically address workforce housing would be appropriate, but at least a year away. The board felt that a first step was to better understand the challenges facing developers when trying to build "affordable" units. Halleran will confer with town counsel to make sure that our existing ordinance is adequate while a well thought out response to this new law change is crafted.
