The meeting began at 7:15 PM.

The committee discussed the potential needs of a new Meriden Library building, including approximate square footage. Mary is talking to Meriden Library employees for feedback, and plans to report their responses at the next full Building Committee meeting.

All present agreed that a new building should be one floor and fit in with the look of surrounding buildings in Meriden Village. In addition to shelf space, other possible needs discussed included a multipurpose meeting room (capacity 50), storeroom, enclosed administrative space, handicap bathroom, children's area with glass door, clear sight lines, wider aisles, lower shelves, and expanded parking area.
