School is in session! Plainfield PD has been working with Sue Blair, our new principal, to smooth traffic flow at the school and to review all safety procedures. We welcome Sue to Plainfield and look forward to working with her to insure the safety of all students, staff and visitors at the school.

In addition, our officers are continuing the practice of being at the school as students arrive in the mornings. This gives us a chance to interact and build relationships with students and to provide any needed assistance. Being with Plainfield's children is positive and rewarding way to start our day.

As a reminder to all drivers, school busses are on the road in the morning and afternoon which may cause short traffic delays so plan accordingly. For the safety of all of our children, RSA 265:54 requires all traffic to stop for a school bus which is discharging or boarding students. Vehicles must stop at least 25' from the bus, whether approaching the bus from the front or the rear, and must remain stationary until the bus moves and/or its flashing red lights turn off. If you see any vehicle violating these safety rules, please note the color, type and make of the car as well as the plate number if you can and report it to us at 469-3344. It is up to all of us to keep our children safe!
