The Police Department will be out in force this Halloween season. I encourage everyone to have fun and be safe. I also again request the assistance of everyone out to keep an eye on our community and to call the police if you see anything suspicious. We need your support.

Recommendations for safety:

- 1 4 PM to 8 PM Hours of Trick or Treat
- 2 Trick or Treat when it is still light outside
- 3 Wear a costume that makes it easy for you to walk, see and be seen.
- 4 Try using reflective tape on your costume to be seen easily
- 5 Use makeup instead of a mask
- 6 If someone older cannot go with you, trick or treat with a group
- 7 Cross Roadways at corners or designated areas. Never cross between parked vehicles
- 8 Make sure your parents know where you will be Trick or Treating
- 9 If there are no sidewalks, ALWAYS walk facing traffic

Also The Plainfield PTO will be hosting their "Trunk or Treat" at the School, 92 Bonner Road in Meriden NH. It is my understanding there is a \$ 5.00 fee for this event that supports the PTO.

The Fire Departments will be assisting with traffic control and flow on Rt. 12-A in Plainfield and in the Main Street area of Meriden. Police Officers will be on patrol and will be handing out Safety Glow Necklaces which are completely funded by Townline Equipment and Nationwide Insurance, Guaraldi Agency, "On Your Side."
