

Temporary Plainfield School Board Vacancy

The Plainfield School Board is seeking to fill a vacant school board position from now until the March 2022 election. This is a temporary term and will require attendance at approximately 5 school board meetings. The chosen candidate will need to run again in the March election if they wish to stay on board. The candidate must be a Plainfield, NH resident.

Any letters received after this date will not be considered by the Board. The letter of intent must include your name, physical address, telephone number and email address. Please also describe why you are interested in serving on the Plainfield School Board.

The Plainfield School Board has sole decision making authority in selecting the best candidate for the position. The Board may consider applications at their regularly scheduled school board meeting on December 22, 2021. If several letters of intent are received, the Board will likely deliberate and select the new member at their regularly scheduled school board meeting on January 12, 2022.
