To Public Service of New Hampshire:

We, the undersigned, wish to express our support for finding an alternative to the existing two above ground utility poles erected in the fall of 2006 located on the west side of *Maxfield Parrish Highway*, Route 12A. The poles were placed in this location as part of the utility service for a personal car storage facility located at 830 Route 12A. Currently, all other utility poles in this area are located on the east side of Route 12A, thus not interfering with the view.

The roadside at this location provides a breathtaking, cornerstone view of Plainfield Village and Mt. Ascutney. This view is considered a COMMUNITY CORNERSTONE and is mentioned in numerous MASTER PLANS. It is frequently photographed by visitors, tourists, and residents. The poles are now obstructing the view, which includes both the Maxfield Parrish Highway sign designation and the Welcome to Plainfield sign.

We ask that PSNH reconsider the placement of the poles as they have had a negative impact on a valued landscape and cornerstone view in Plainfield. We request that PSNH assist the Town of Plainfield in finding feasible, reasonable and affordable alternatives so that the poles can be eliminated and that one of Plainfield's cornerstones preserved.
