Please read reverse carefully for recycling information.

Garbage collection is on alternate weeks with stickers. All materials must be curbside by 7:00 a.m. Stickers must be attached to top bag in your barrel. All trash must be in bags not loose in barrel. Each sticker covers 30 lbs of trash.

Recycling should be in low containers (no taller than twenty inches no wider than eighteen inches) easy to pick up.

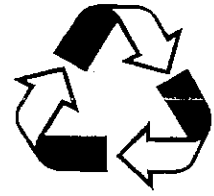

Plainfield Curbside Program

Curbside Pick-up is every other week from trash pick-up.

The following may be recycled at the curb:



Newspapers – clean & dry

Catalogs, boxboard & mixed paper

Cereal, pasta, non-cardboard boxes (no corrugation), all catalogs and mixed paper (No Kraft paper-brown paper bags)

Plastic-PET & HDPE #1 & #2 - Rinsed out and flattened. Milk, Soda and with caps removed. No wide mouthed containers, i.e.: margarine & yogurt

Glass – No dishware or window. Canning & mason jars are ok. Rinsed out – no caps.

Aluminum & Tin Cans – Labels okay, rinse – do not flatten.

Extended Recycling at The Lebanon Solid Waste Facility

370 Plainfield Road, West Lebanon

Monday – Friday: 8:30am – 5:00pm

Saturday: 8:30am – 2:00pm

Cardboard – Thick brown corrugated cardboard & brown paper bags

Plastic – Will accept ALL plastic bottles #1 - #7's with a "neck" (i.e. pill bottles)

Mixed Glass – Rinse clean, remove caps separate: brown, green or clear. Also included with Mixed Glass are ceramics, mirrors, Pyrex, window or leaded glass.

Scrap Metal – Residential scrap metal only, "white goods" such as washing machines, dryers and stoves accepted at no charge.

Books – Hard or soft cover used books in good condition may be left or picked up at the book shelf. Please check with Plainfield Libraries first.

See Attendant for the following items:

Fluorescent Bulbs – All sizes – household only

Mercury devices – Thermostats, thermometers, switches, etc.

Rechargeable batteries: Ni-Cd, Li-Ion, Ni-MH, small Pb-Acid and Mercury Button Cell.

Automotive Batteries – Car, Truck & Marine batteries

Motor Oil: Used motor oil, do not mix with gasoline or antifreeze – Limit 2 gallons per trip.

The following items are accepted for a fee:

Freon Units & Appliances: Refrigerators, air conditioners, microwaves and dehumidifiers are accepted for a fee.

Tanks: 1 lb. and 20 lb propane tanks and fire extinguishers are also accepted for a fee.

Electronics: Computer, Monitors, lap tops, televisions, flat screen TV's, and CPU's are accepted for recycling. Monitors and TV's are accepted for a fee.

Tires: Passenger car tires, Truck tires and farm & construction tires for a fee.
