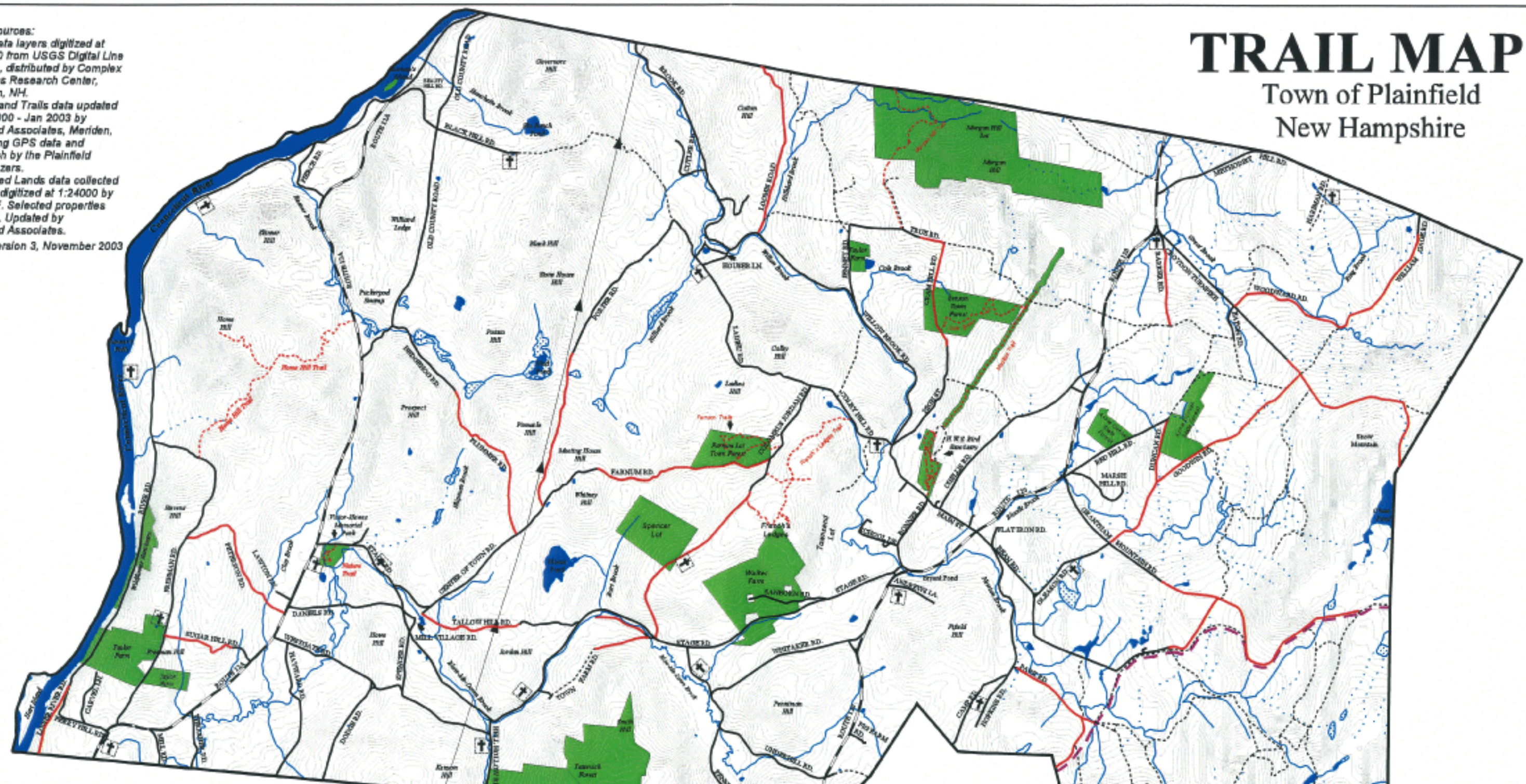


TRAIL MAP
